Smith snuck past race leader Green Bay's Mike Coel on the final lap when Coel and Pulaski's Rod Snellenberger locked horns in turn two while battling for second.



DePere's Troy DeGrave survived several cautions and collected his first feature flag of the season. Rookie Chad Kaminski of Luxemburg turned in his finest performance of the year finishing second. Abram's Scott Boyea, Oconto Falls Eric Arneson and Kewaunee's Brian Bruechert rounded out the top five finishers.
